



Development Within the City

Planning is underway for the 25th anniversary celebration, June 4-6, Creve Coeur Park. Sponsorships available.

The Maryland Heights Conventions and Visitors Bureau has moved into Government Center as of January 21.

Progress Parkway/Old Dorsett at Dorsett Road relocation - project should be awarded this month and construction should begin soon after.

Dorsett/270 and Page/270 project

Construction of a diverging diamond interchange at I-270 and Dorsett

MoDOT and its contractor Fred Weber Inc. plan to begin construction in January 2010 or earlier, depending on the completion of the I-64 project.

This project is expected to be completed by winter 2010.

Dorsett will remain open during construction. A temporary bridge will be built to carry I-270 traffic.

Construction of a flyover ramp at I-270 and Route 364 (Page Avenue)

MoDOT and Fred Weber Inc. will begin construction of a northbound I-270 flyover ramp to westbound Route 364 (Page Avenue).

Construction will start in spring 2010. The Page project is expected to be completed by winter 2011.

The I-270 and Dorsett/Page project also includes bridge rehabilitation at Marine Avenue and I-270. This work is scheduled to begin in spring 2010.
